
Rachael and I are really enjoying this season. We've already passed last years winners tally and have won over £300,000 in prize money. At present we have 40 horses riding out, while a handful are resting.





Meet Cameron Iles:

Cameron joined us in October 2020 following a stint as an apprentice jockey on the flat. He's now got his conditional license and had his first 2 rides for us in February. Both were on Jepeck, (pictured right) who continues to thrive at 13 years old and finished 2nd in both races. He then had another ride coming 4th on Jepeck in March at Uttoxeter in a £50,000 Handicap Hurdle. January gave us 8 winners (including Firestream, pictured left) as did February, bringing the season total to 32 winners so far, 32 2nds and 26 3rds. We're currently brewing up for Aintree, where we plan to have some runners.



The 5-2-Follow competition continues to run. We had 96 entries this year which will raise a fantastic amount of money for the Somerset and Dorset Air Ambulance. Currently in 1st place is Jonathan Prew, 2nd Gill Langford and 3rd Cary Dale. The leaderboard is forever changing with the prizes all still to play for!

Rouquine Sauvage and Kilconny Bridge are both in foal to Passing Glance. They will soon be foaling at Overbury Stud. We were very keen to use Passing Glance following the past success we had with Fountains Windfall. Then the mares will be covered by Jack Hobbs before returning to Potwell Farm for their summer at grass with the foals.

She won her sole race impressively in a filly's bumper, when three, after which the Racing Post reported: "She hails from a good jumping family. She ran green but came from an unpromising position to snatch the verdict in the final strides. With only two of the eleven having run before, the form is hard to assess but she will improve markedly for the experience."

The stunning filly is by Soldier of Fortune, with whom Anthony has already tasted success, most recently with Serious Charges. The dam, Northwood Milan, was unraced but was by Milan and is the sister to 8 winners including two black type performers, Fagan and Sunni May, as well as Creevytennant. She's from the family of Morley Street and Granville Again.

After her run she was given a break to mature further. She's now ready to go again and will run in a

bumper in April or May, with the target of the mares' listed bumper at Cheltenham in the autumn.
